This is a highly regarded and valuable award, which will help your child to develop a wide range of skills. The award is broken down into 4 sections, all of which must be completed to gain certification.

Mendip Outdoor Pursuits – Expedition

Fairfield High School has invited Mendip Outdoor Pursuits to provide training and safety supervision for the expedition section of the award. Mendip Outdoor Pursuits has been providing D of E training courses since 1990; and are a D of E Approved Activity Provider. Mendip Outdoor Pursuits trained and qualified facilitators have had many years of experience working with a large number of school and colleges. The D of E training has strong elements of team work incorporated within the framework and Fairfield High School believes that this benefits the students in furthering their academic careers.

The course will cover the following elements:

- First Aid and Emergency Procedures
- An Awareness of Risk and Health and Safety Issues
- Navigation and Route Planning
- Preparatory Map Skills
- Practical Map Skills
- Compass Skills
- Camp Craft Equipment and Hygiene
- Food and Cooking
- Countryside, Highway and Water Sports Codes
- Observation Recording and Presentations
- Team-building
- Proficiency in the Mode of Travel

Attendance on each of the training days, and the training and assessment expeditions is mandatory for completion of the Expedition section of the Award.

Commitments

Teams of students will be required to meet a number of deadlines over the course and attend regular briefings and meetings in school to review their training and also following the assessment plan. The dates of all these will be given out at the first training session supported by emails, notice boards and extra resources. Its important that we make it clear that students behaviour and attitude needs to be in line with school policy whilst out of the school grounds.

Cost : Total Cost, per pupil: £175

The cost will include all the training, transport to expeditions and group equipment, but you would need to provide your own food and some camping equipment. The DofE offer discounts to camping equipment stores which can be access through the website.

A £40 non-refundable deposit is required by Friday 22nd of October 2021. This deposit will confirm participants place on the DofE award. Payment can be made via Payments in ParentMail.

***Please note the deposit is non-refundable as this will be used to cover the cost of sign up to the award.**

The deadline for further payments is **Friday 17th of December 2021**, however you are welcome to pay in full from the start.
